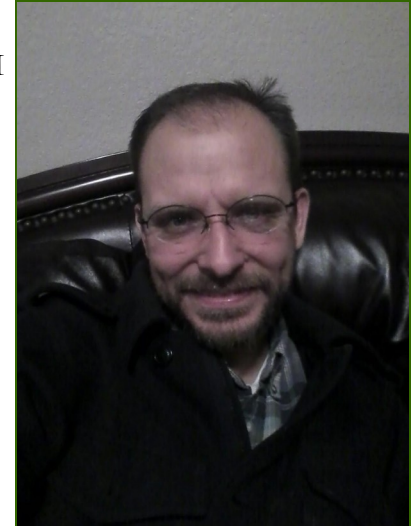




Staff Update
