I'm 19, and I went to North Dakota to work for an oil and gas company. I went in June and came back in August with enough money to support myself until I could get my license and a job.

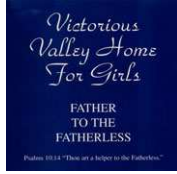
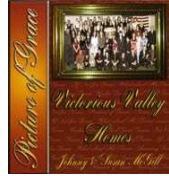
