- I want this year to be a year of **SEEING**.


Vs. 1: "In the year that King Uzziah died I saw also the Lord."

Boys' Home Update

Hi, my name is Joseph Denlinger. I'm twenty years old, and I have been at the home for five years. I was born to a family hooked on crack, and this caused the State to take my brother, sister, and me away from them. They were given a chance to get us back, but drugs and each other meant more to them than their kids, so we were put into the foster care system. My sister and I were passed from foster home to foster home.

During this time, my brother had found a foster family (our adoptive parents) that were willing to adopt him. My biological mother then asked if they would be willing to adopt all three of us together. This was made possible when the last foster family decided not to adopt my sister and me.

We moved into a Godly, loving home. Since my new family went to church every Sunday, I heard the Gospel at a very young age. I still remember the night when I was saved.

I was seven years old, and our church was having Vacation Bible School. The preacher had been preaching on sin — reminding us that all have sinned. I remember clearly the point in the message when I realized I was lost. He had just mentioned that stealing was a sin, and the example he used was of someone stealing a sucker. Earlier that day, I had stolen a sucker! I remember nothing else that he said until the invitation. I just had to get saved! I remember after I stopped crying enough to see that everything looked newer, that everything also felt newer.

Since that night, I have tried my best to live a good Christian life, but this seemed to get me nowhere. In fact, the more I tried, the more trouble I got into.

At the age of thirteen, I started to rebel against my parents—never outwardly, but always in my head. I was attending a public school, and I was introduced to stuff that has haunted my mind ever since. Because I was learning so little at this public school, my parents put me into a charter school, but things only got worse, so my parents tried homeschooling. Having the extra time, I only got into more trouble.

My parents had heard of the Victorious Valley Home from some friends of ours, who happened to have a daughter in the home. They gave me the choice to come or not. I thought it would be fun, and I saw that my parents really wanted me to go, so I decided to come.

Since then I have learned so much—about God, and just about life. I have had some of the best teachers, the Holy Ghost being one, but also many human teachers. I thank God I chose to come here, for who knows where I would be if I hadn't come?
